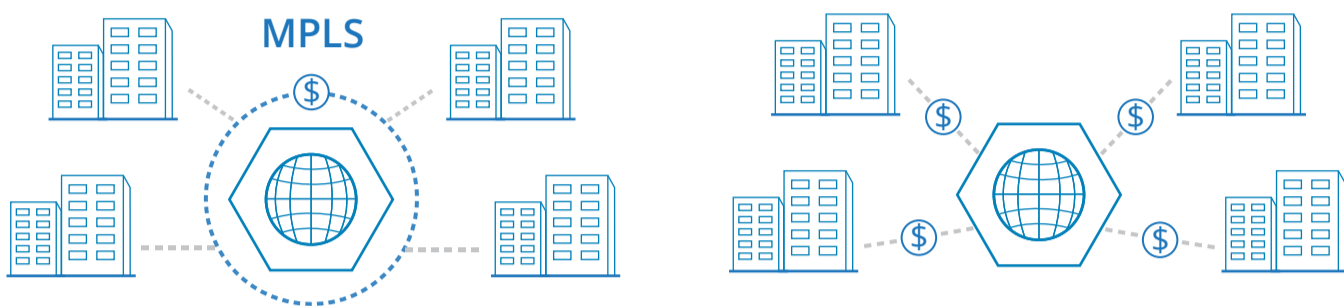
8 Reasons Your Company Should Consider MPLS

1. Any-to-Any Connectivity



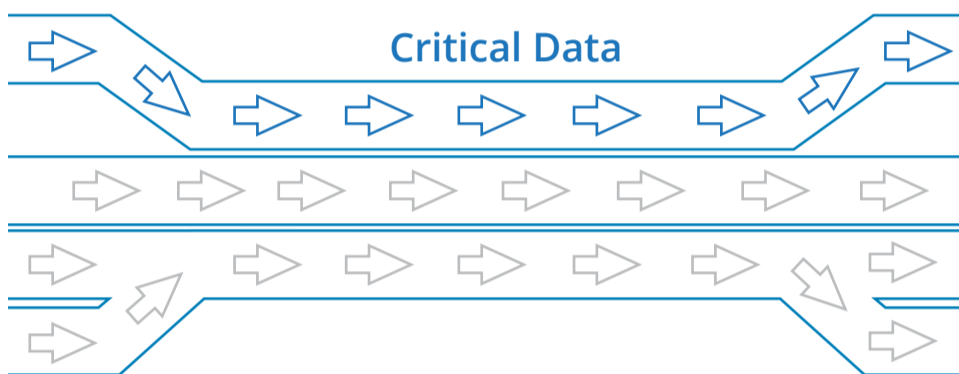
MPLS interconnects multiple sites together. This works well for businesses with multiple branch offices and remote workers.

2. Cost-Effective



Instead of paying for separate internet connections between all office locations, only pay for one and pool your bandwidth between sites.

3. Quality of Service



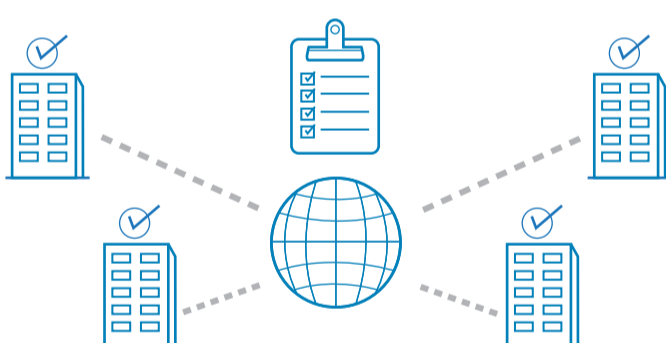
MPLS is a protocol that labels data packets and sends them based on priority to ensure lowest latency paths for your mission critical data like voice and video.

4. Bandwidth Efficiency



Since MPLS packets are always sent on time and in the right order, it uses less data to perform those daily functions.

5. Service Level Agreements (SLAs)



An SLA guarantees your business receives the service and speed as promised by the provider.

6. Security



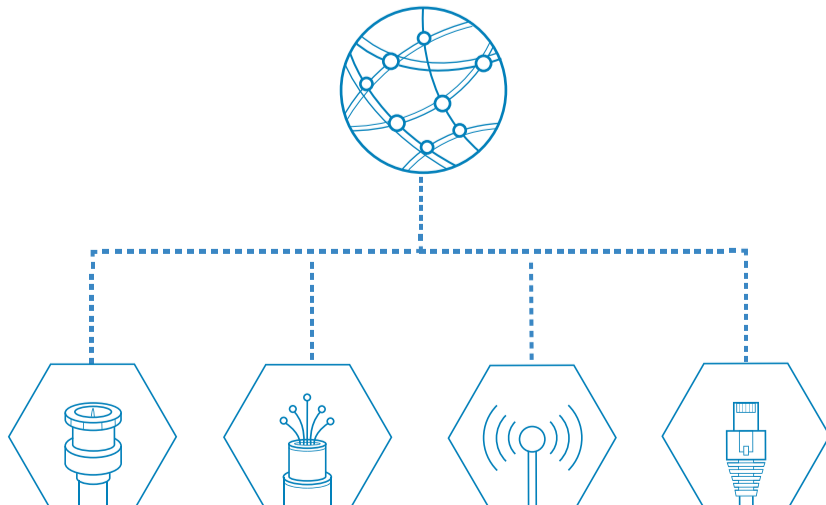
MPLS creates a Layer 2 connection between all sites. Only those in your private network will have access to your critical data.

7. Network Visibility



Network Admins have full visibility of their MPLS network.
This transparency enables administrators to troubleshoot better and faster as it's easier to pinpoint and fix any issues.

8. Varying Ethernet Access



MPLS can connect varying ethernet accesses. For example, a head office on fibre will seamlessly communicate in the same private MPLS network as their branch office on ADSL and remote workers on a cable connection.
